Education during 1962-63

Re: Letter No. 101/1962-7, dated 21st April 1963 from
the Director of Education, M.S. Poona.

Resolutions:- It has been decided by Government that in every
district in the State there should be at least one College of
Education (Secondary training College). At present only the
districts of Handed, Parbhani, Buldhana, Nashik and Kolaba do not
have a College of Education, with a view to providing Colleges
of Education in these Dist. It has been decided as under:-

(A) The Graduate Study Training Centre, Dhulia should be
shifted from the current academic year (i.e. 1962-63) and it
should be established as a Government College of Education at
Parbhani providing courses leading to B.Ed. Degree. The furniture
etc. of the Centre should also be shifted to Parbhani. The
existing seats of the Government Single Training College Dhulia should
continue after the shifting of the Centre and its reestab-
lishment as Govt. College of Education at Parbhani, the seats
to be abolished and seats to be newly created up to 25th February
1963 in the first instance, as also provision for P.A. and
Contract and non contract contingencies of the disposal of the
College of Education of Parbhani are indicated in Appendix A. The
Government College of Education, Parbhani should be accommodated in
the existing building of the Government Junior College of Education
so as to develop it into a comprehensive College of Education and
renamed as Govt. College of Education, Parbhani. The existing post of the Principal, Govt.
Junior College of Education, Parbhani should be held in abeyance
until further orders. Mention is also accorded to the receipt
of Rs. 2,000 (two thousand only) in receipt of the shifting
of the Graduate Study Training Centre, Dhulia to Parbhani.

(B) (1) The Government Junior College of Education, Wal, Dist.
Satara, Govt. Additional Junior College of Education for men,
Handed and Government Additional Junior College of Education
for women, Amavadi, should be closed down from the academic year
1962-63 and instead, three new Govt. Colleges of Education should
be established respectively at Handed, Buldhana and Nashik
from the academic year 1963-64. The furniture etc. at the three
Junior Colleges of Education should be shifted to the new places
for the use of the College of Education as under:-

Government is also pleased to direct as under:-

(1) The Govt. College of Education, Nanded, should be accommodated in the building of the Govt. Junior College of Education, Nanded, which should be gradually developed into a comprehensive college. The Govt. Junior College of Education, Nanded, should be held in abeyance until further orders.

(2) The Govt. College of Education at Muldhana should be accommodated in the building of the Govt. Junior College of Education, Muldhana, which should be gradually developed into a comprehensive college. The Govt. (3) The Govt. College of Education at Kotal should be accommodated in the building of the Govt. Junior College of Education, Kotal, which should be gradually developed into a comprehensive college. The Govt. Junior College of Education, Kotal, should be held in abeyance until further orders.

(4) The existing posts at the 3 Junior Colleges of Education to be closed from 1.6.1958 those mentioned in paragraph 1.3(i) above should be treated as abolished with the creation of the staff of new Govt. colleges of Education.

(5) sanction is also accorded to the expenditure of Rs. 2000/- (Rs. nine thousand only) @ Rs. 2000/- per College for shifting of the furniture etc. of the College as indicated above.

The action taken by the Director of Education, Maharashtra in the month of August 1957 in sanctioning for affiliation of the Govt. College of Education, Nanded, Muldhana and Kotal to the University of Bombay and the expenditure of Rs. 1,500/- in each case and two hundred rupees on account of application of Rs. 200/- per college in an application of Govt. sanction is approved.

The expenditure involved in the project mentioned in para 1(a) and 1(b) above should be debited to the Budget Head '20. Education - University - Govt. professional colleges - Training - Colleges for Secondary Teachers - Demand No. 60 and should be met from the sanctioned grants in the Budget during the current financial year 1958-59.

The expenditure on account of the project sanctioned in para 1(c) above should be debited to the Budget Head '20. Education - University - Govt. professional colleges - Training - Colleges for Secondary Teachers - Demand No. 60 and should initially be met from out of the advance of Rs. 60,000/- from the Govt. of Maharashtra (sanctioned under Govt. Department of Finance Department) and Rs. 1500/- from the Budget during the year 1958-59.

The advance from the contingency fund should be recovered by the Government of Maharashtra in making sanction of the project. The Director of Education, Maharashtra should be requested to forward to the Govt. in Nanded and Kotal the total sanctioned amount also the details of the project. Accountant General, Maharashtra, Nanded, should be kept notified.
